

GUIDELINES FOR THE INTERDANCE FOUNDATION APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

Applications to InterDance will be reviewed twice a year. Deadlines for submission are May 15 and September 15.

Application

The narrative should be no more than 3 pages, excluding support materials, and must include the following information:

- Genre of traditional dance, including the specific dance(s) to be studied.
- Master Teacher: A description of master teacher and his/her qualifications.
- Apprentice: A description of the student and his/her qualifications. Please include any previous relationship with the Master teacher.
- Project: Describe in detail the specific goals of the project and provide a basic lesson plan.
- Budget: Specify the master teacher's fees for the time period covered by the project.

Support Materials

- Video or DVD up to 3 minutes each for master and student.
- Bios, photos, programs, reviews, press clippings, where relevant.
- Letter of commitment from the master teacher agreeing to carry out the training program.
